The history behind Talabgaon Castle began in the early 18th century when In order to maintain his great loyalty he first sought approval to fight from Thakur Sardul Singh Kupawat Rathore of Ramasari, Jodhpur came to visit Maharaja of Jodhpur and it was granted. As fate would have it the war was his relatives of Samodh with his army and servants. After staying in jaipur won by Jaipur and in honor of the true valor and loyalty shown by Thakur with his relatives for several months war broke out between the States of Sardul Singh ji Rathore and his men, the "Jagir" or Thikana (State) of Jaipur and Jodhpur over the much sought after Sambhur Lake which was Talabgaon, and its adjoining villages, were bestowed upon him to rule over.

Talabgaon Castle which stands today was built in 1900 by Thakur Vijay As they had eaten "the salt" of Jaipur the code of honor among Rajpur's Singh ji Rathore, a direct decedent, and remains in the family today. Talabgaon is the only Jagir of Kupawat Rathors in the erstwhile State of




